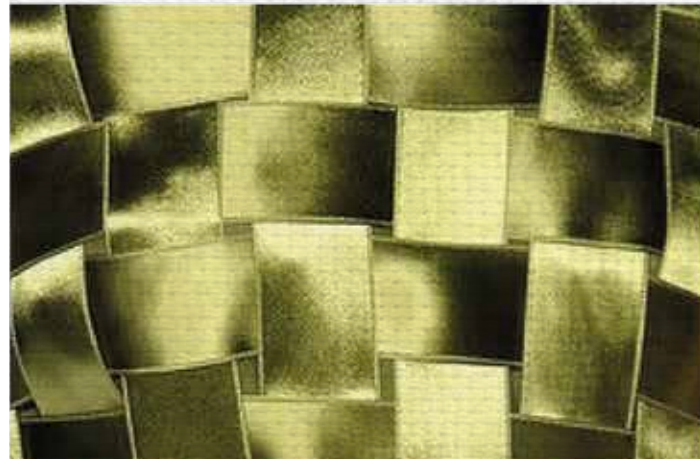
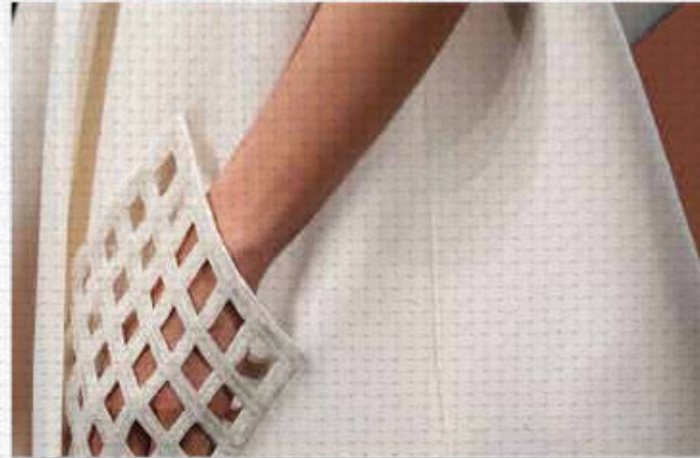




DESIGN VISION

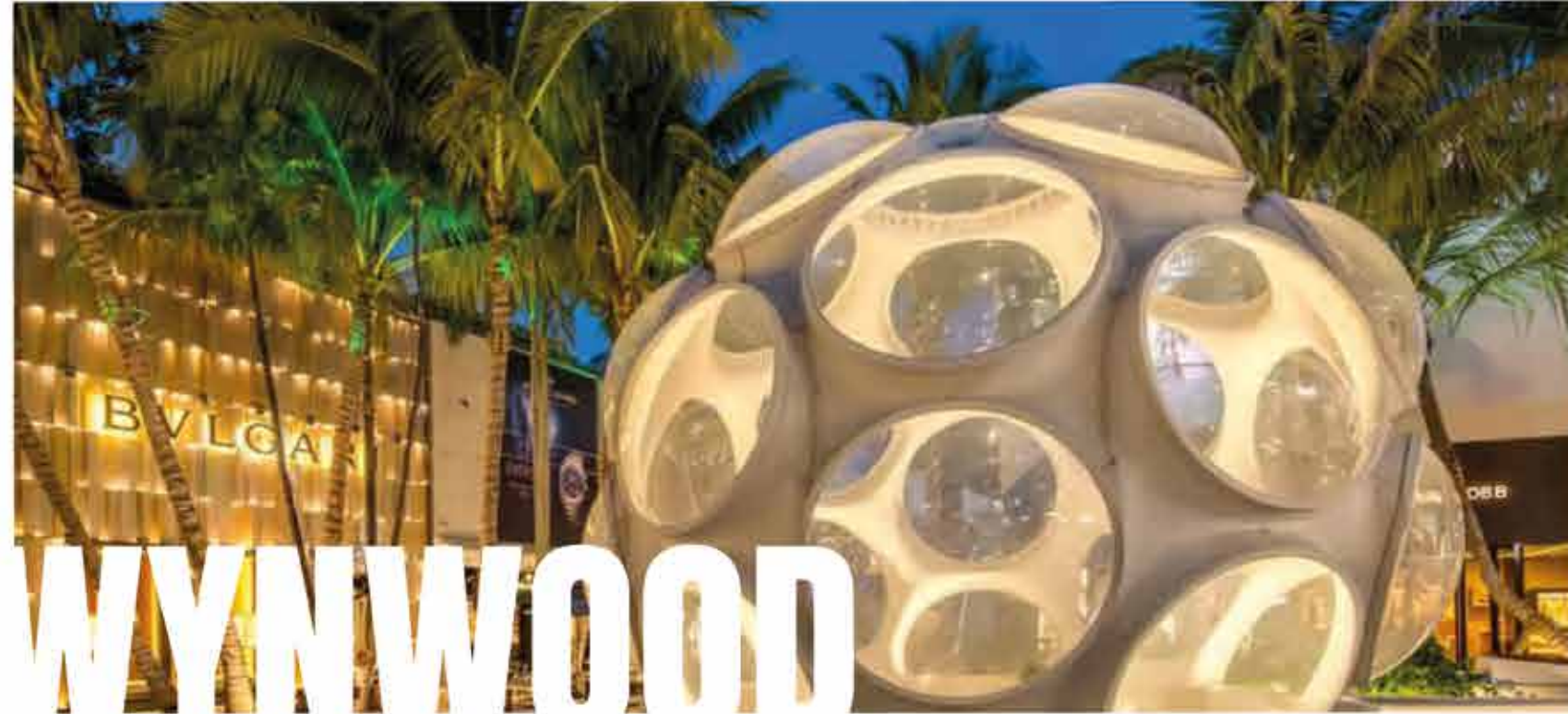
LOCATION:

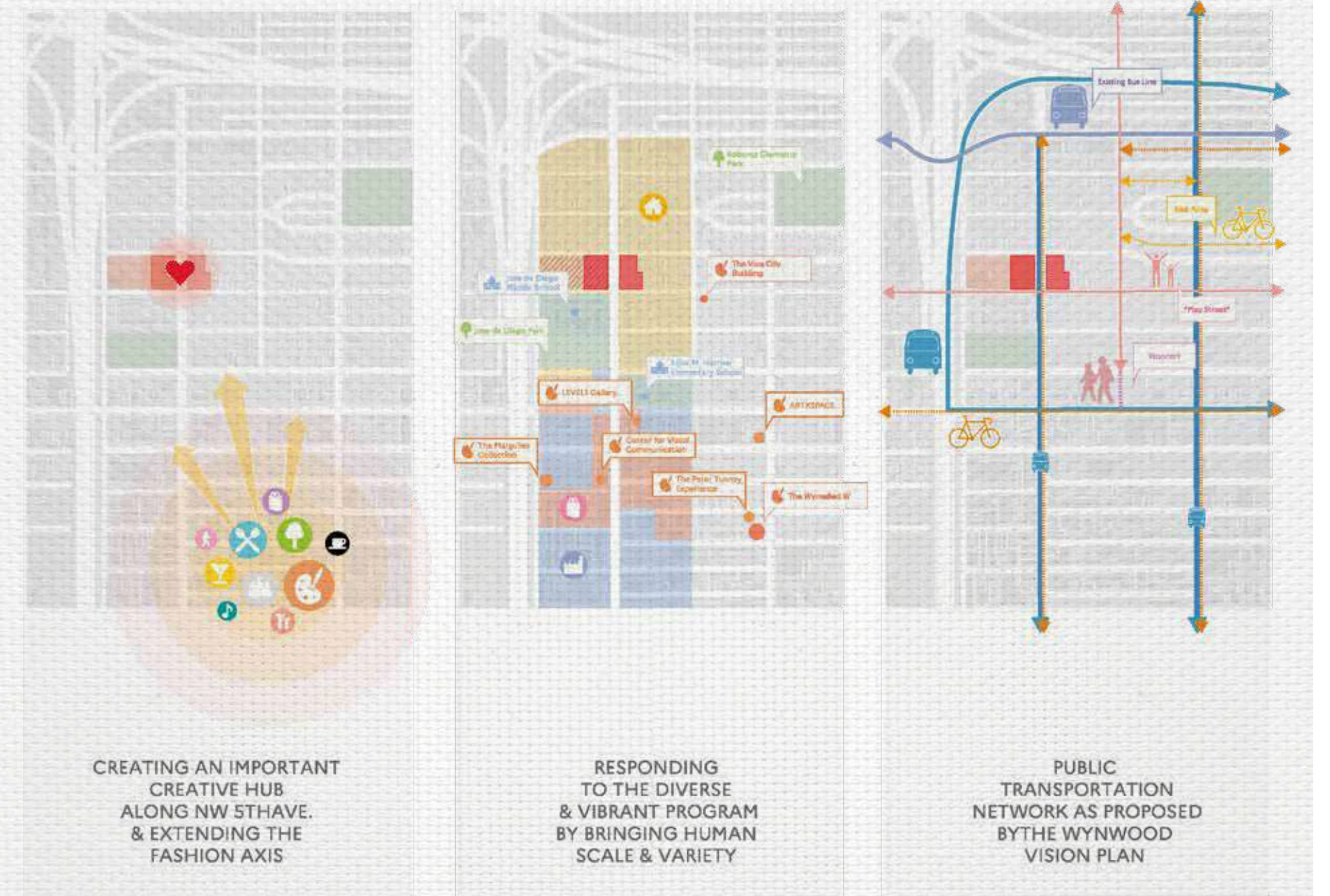

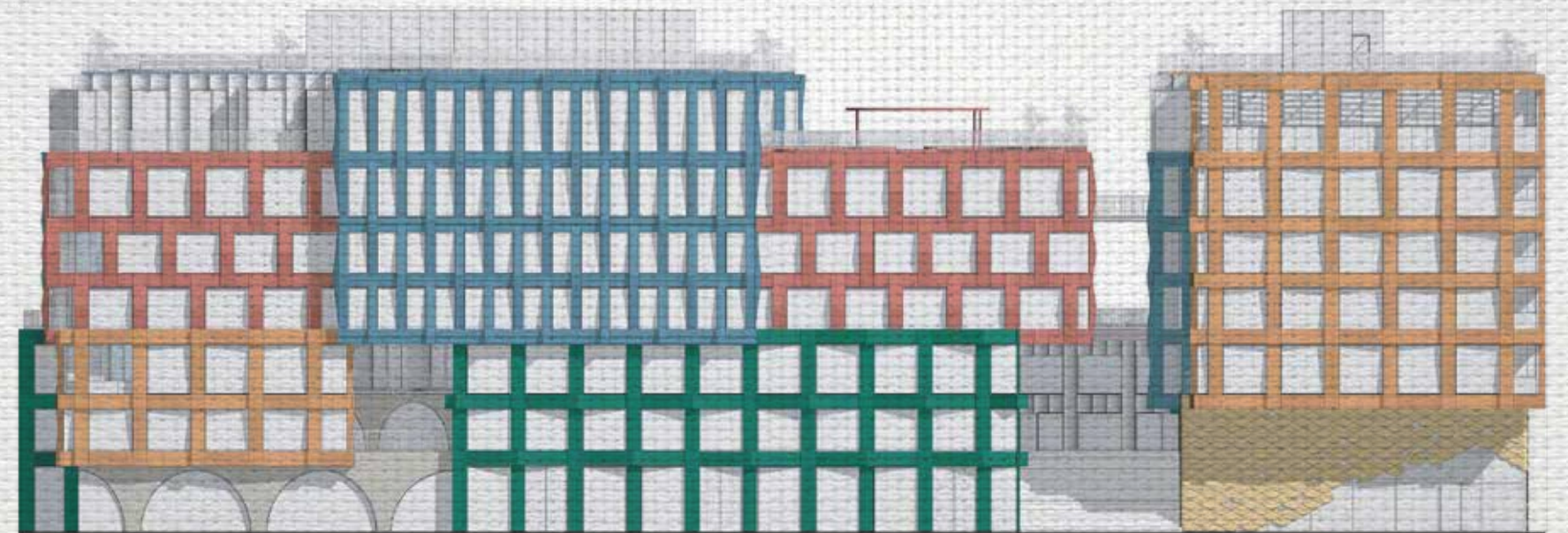

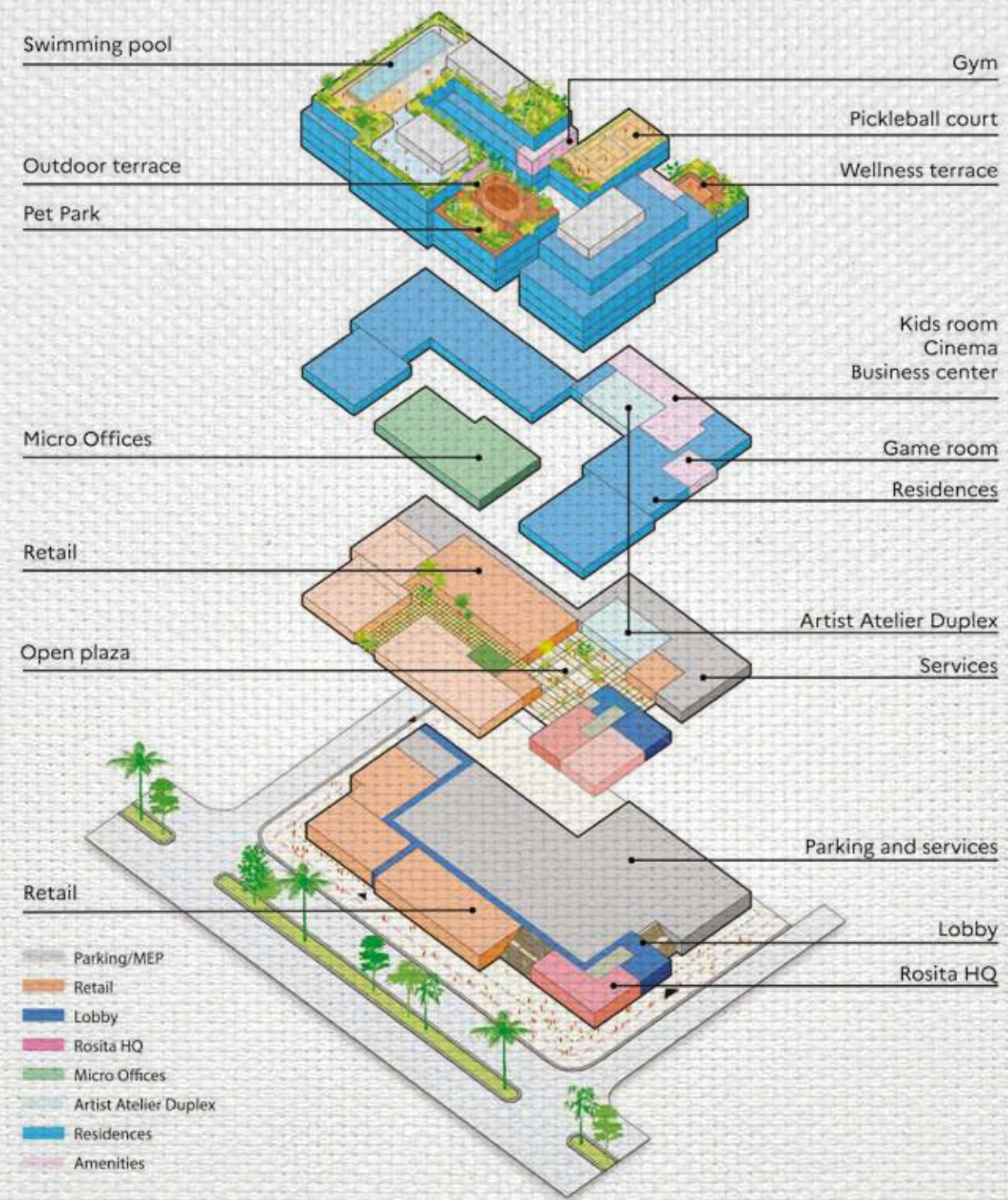
WOMA also incorporates a forward-thinking ownership model, offering micro-offices. Storage units are available for acquisition through usage rights.

WHAT'S INSIDE

WOMA is a condo where residential living meets work-from-home flexibility, everyday retail, and amenities designed for relaxation and connection.





Exclusive amenities enhance the residential experience: a wellness terrace complemented by a sauna, steam room, fitness area, and an outdoor pickleball court, create a holistic environment for relaxation, activity, and well-being.

A rooftop communal terrace, beautifully designed, offers panoramic views and shared social spaces, with a semi-olympic pool surrounded by lush landscaping and garden lounges for relaxation.

Those who prefer to work from home benefit from a contemporary business center with meeting rooms. These amenities are complemented by a cinema, a kids' room, and a game room, offering spaces that perfectly complement residents' lifestyles. Additionally, a pet park on the terrace makes this a truly pet-friendly living environment.

Grounded in a purpose of community-building, an open plaza at the mezzanine level is framed by shops that serve as a vibrant social and cultural hub.

At street level, along 32nd Street, 5th Avenue, and 33rd Street, retail activates the urban edge, together sustaining a continuous dialogue between the building and its neighborhood and reinforcing WOMA's role as a new point of connection between living, working, and culture in Wynwood Norte.

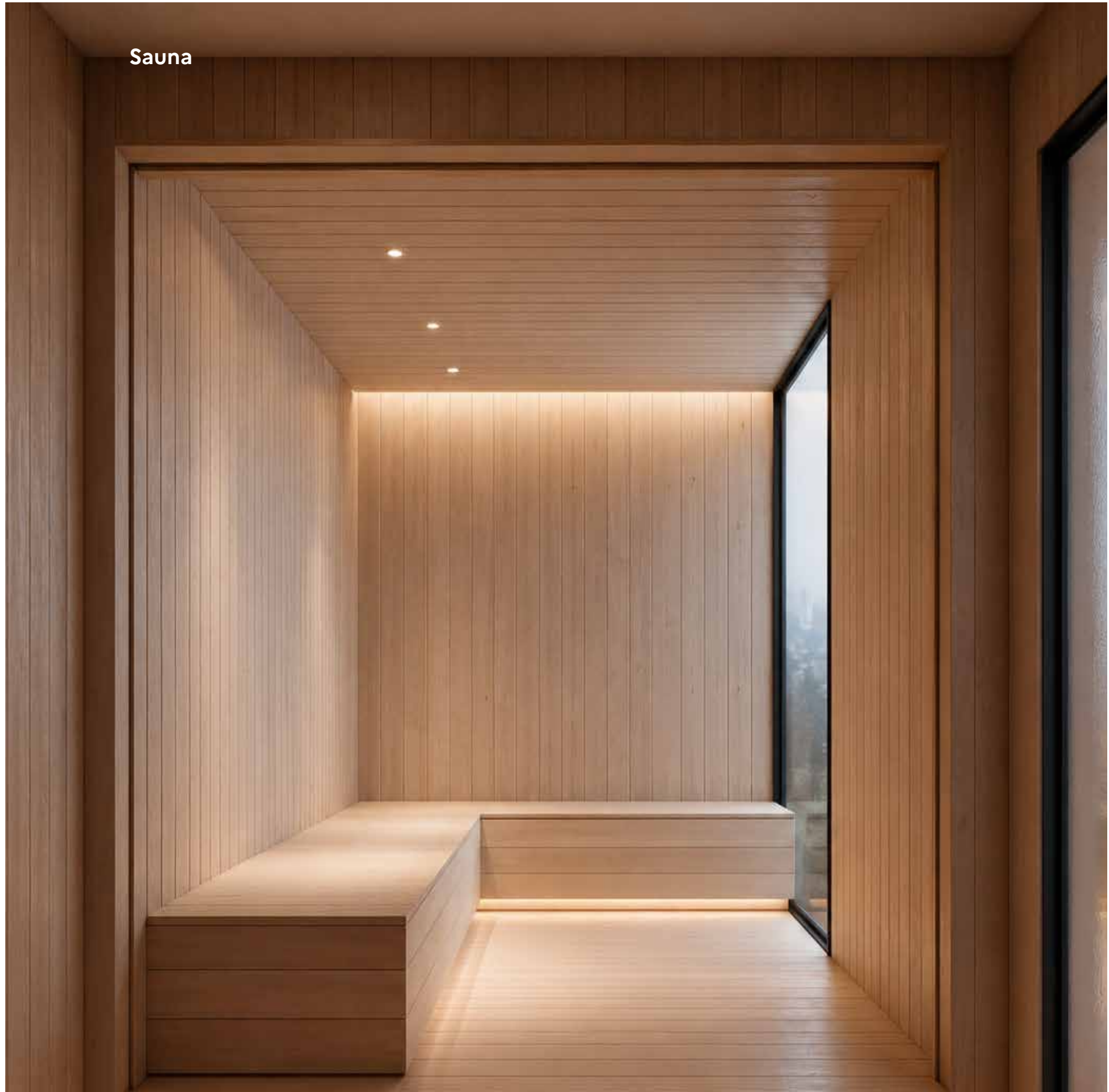

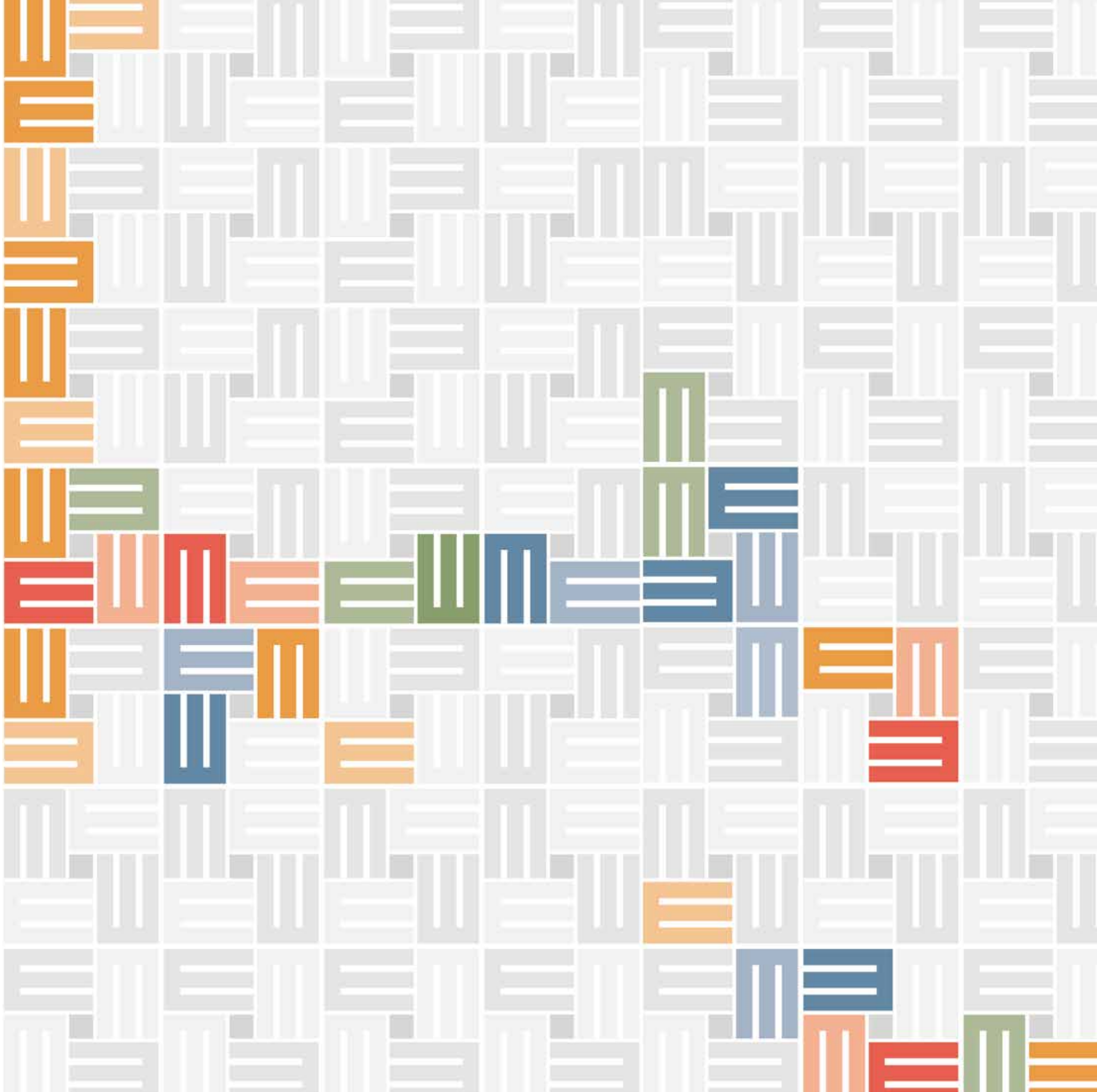

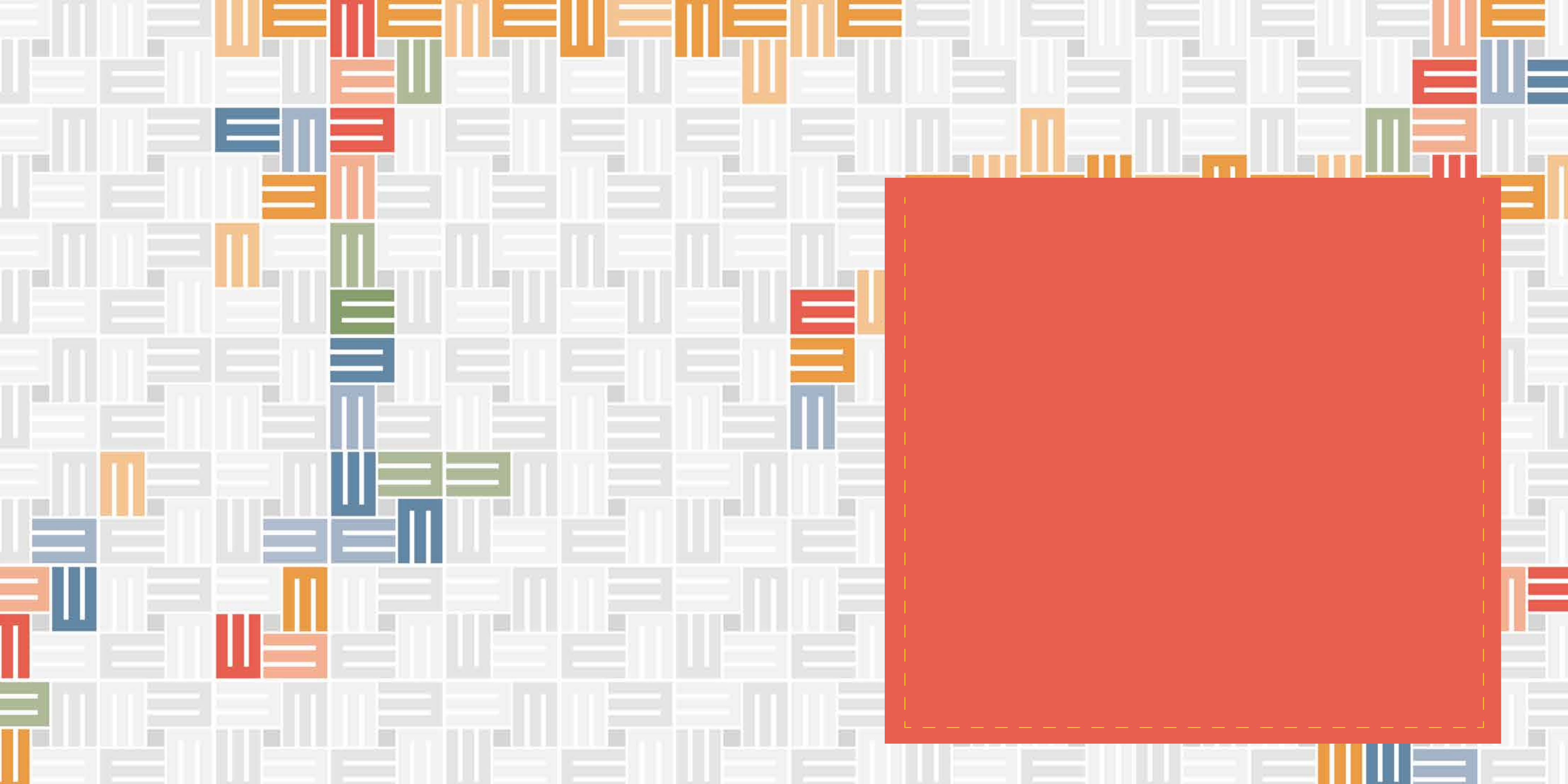
